For Rooms That Are Bright and Bubbly

The Bubble Chandelier, made of hand-blown glass and nickel-plated steel, is the first lighting fixture released by Lindsey Adelman, a former partner with David Weeks in the design studio Butter, under her own name. Ms. Adelman, above, who is an artist as well as a lighting designer, said the idea for the chandelier emerged from her artwork, which emphasizes similar shapes and often incorporates locks of hair (sometimes her own). "The chandelier design is one manifestation of my obsessive drawings," she said, "where spheres are overlapping in space."
